

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP AGREEMENT

As the National Accreditation Body for Belarus,

BSCA

agrees to comply, as an EA Associate Member in accordance with the EA Articles of Association, and with the provisions and requirements laid down in the applicable EA policy and requirement documents.

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing we shall, in particular, uphold and fulfil the following obligations:

- to abide by the EA Rules of Procedure;
- to support the aims and objectives of EA, including the recognition and promotion of the EA Multilateral Agreement (the MLA);
- to return ballots within prescribed timeframes;
- to offer representatives, whenever appropriate and feasible, to attend EA meetings and support EA technical work;
- to contribute to the efficient resolution of any complaints received by EA in circumstances where our organisation is involved;
- to uphold copyright on EA publications and security arrangements for internal/committee documents; and
- to not make any references which may be inferred that our organisation has MLA signatory status unless this status has been agreed by the EA General Assembly.



We agree to provide EA at any time information on the measures taken to fulfil the above obligations. We further understand that failure to uphold or fulfil the above obligations and any other requirements that may be established by EA for EA Membership may result in termination of such Membership in accordance with Article 6.3 of the EA Articles of Association.
